In order to be eligible

- Applicants must be a current EFSC club member in good standing
- Applicants must be at least 12 years old
- Applicants must have successfully completed Free Skate Level 3
- Applicants must be able to commit to one lesson day (Tue or Sat) for the full session
- Applicants will be required to register as an Instructor on the Learn to Skate USA website at their own cost (\$20.00), complete the Instructor Certification Course and agree to associated waivers and releases. If the applicant is 18 or older, completion of the LTS background check and SafeSport Training (at applicants own cost) will also be required.
